- An overall limitation on tax expenditures (28% or other cap)
- A possible cap on certain deductions/exclusions (dollar limit)
- Retirement USA Funds (as [proposed](#) by Senator Tom Harkin (D-IA))
- Criticism of coverage and adequacy under current system

Lynn Dudley, senior vice president, policy, will moderate the call. She will be joined by **Kent Mason**, of *Davis & Harman, LLP*, who will discuss these topics and the recent legislative and regulatory developments affecting them.
