Preparing for PPACA** series with a special joint webinar with America’s Health Insurance Plans (AHIP) on **Monday, December 10 at 3:00 p.m. Eastern Time**, to discuss the recently [proposed regulations addressing incentives for nondiscriminatory wellness programs](#) under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA).

As we reported in the [November 20 Benefits Byte](#), the new rules would increase the maximum permissible reward under a health-contingent wellness program offered in connection with a group health plan (and any related health insurance coverage) from 20 percent to 30 percent of the cost of coverage – and up to 50 percent for programs designed to prevent or reduce tobacco use.
