The American Benefits Council will host a **Benefits Passport Webinar** on **Thursday, March 7 at 2:00 p.m. Eastern Time**, to discuss the use of pooling and captive insurance as a tool for controlling benefit costs in the multinational context.

With a pooling contract, a corporation with two or more locations can spread insurance risk by joining a larger pool of insured individuals. A captive involves an insurance or reinsurance company whose business is primarily supplied and controlled by its owners — typically the principal insureds. These owners/insureds participate by controlling the underwriting, claims and investment decisions of the insurance company.

Lynn Dudley, senior vice president, retirement and international benefits policy, will moderate the call. She will be joined by **Sabina Marotta**, from L-3 Communications, and **Kathleen Waslov**, of Willis, who will discuss their experiences with these benefits management tools.
