- health reimbursement arrangements (HRA) clarifications provided under [Frequently Asked Questions \(FAQ\) Part XI](#);
- coverage of preventive services as described under [FAQ Part XII](#);
- [interim final regulations](#) establishing whistleblower protections for employees who file complaints against their employer for certain violations under PPACA; and
- Informational reporting under PPACA sections 6055 and 6056, as prescribed under IRS notices [2012-32](#) and [2012-33](#).
