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The American Benefits Council will continue its **P4P ... Preparing for PPACA** series on **Friday, September 27, at 2 p.m. Eastern Time**, to discuss the Internal Revenue Service’s (IRS) recently proposed regulations governing employer reporting under sections 6055 and 6056 of the Internal Revenue Code, as added by PPACA. Expert speakers, including a representative from the IRS, will discuss the regulations and answer questions.

As we reported in the [September 5 Benefits Byte](#), The [proposed regulations under Section 6055](#) set forth the methodology for reporting specific information for each individual for whom minimum essential coverage is provided. The [proposed regulations for Section 6056](#) set forth the methodology for reporting the terms and conditions of the health care coverage provided to the employer's full-time employees during the year.

As we have previously indicated, the Section 6055 and 6056 reporting requirements have been delayed under [Notice 2013-45](#) and will not be effective until 2015, but the IRS is encouraging voluntary reporting for coverage in 2014.
