**Membership Legislative/Regulatory Update Webinar**

The Council will host a membership webinar on Tuesday, August 5, from 3 to 4:30 p.m., to provide an outlook on what is expected for retirement, health and related tax issues affecting employer-sponsored benefits for the remainder of the year.

With Congress scheduled to begin its summer recess in early August, and with the election homestretch shortly thereafter, any legislative action will occur during a relatively truncated Fall session or, significantly, in a post-election “lame duck” session. The webinar will address the most pertinent developments related to health care and retirement policy. In particular, certain pension plan measures continue to be “in play” as revenue offsets for unrelated spending priorities.

Of course, the regulatory agenda is not restricted by the legislative calendar. As detailed in the [May 29 Benefits Byte](#), executive branch agencies with jurisdiction over benefits matters have a number of implementation priorities to be addressed in the coming months.
